Non-slip Decking Hardwood Floor Protector

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PRODUCT

Specially formulated lazure for application on exterior wood decking, such as those around swimming pools or on decks where, being tropical hardwoods, traditional solvent-based coverings produce problems when it comes to drying, taking days or even, depending on the type of wood, do not dry completely.

XYLAZEL Sol Decking Non-slip Protector for Hardwood Floors is formulated with a combination of hybrid acrylic resins and polyurethane copolymers which provide it with the advantages of solvent-based (penetrability, uniformity, resistance to blocking) and water-based products (quick drying, tough weather protection, easy to apply).

It contains additives which provide a slightly granulated non-slip surface.

For the protection and decoration of exterior or interior decking, furniture and joinery, especially those manufactured with tropical woods such as iroko, teak, ipe, cumaru, acacia, autoclave-treated pine, etc.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

Density at 20° C: 1.02 ± 0.02 g/ml Dry to the touch: approximately 1 hour, although this depends on the type of wood.

Dry for recoating: Around 3 hours, depending on the type of wood.

3. INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation of the surface Apply on clean and dry surfaces. Remove flaked and loose oils, paints and varnishes, either by stripping, scraping or sanding.

Protect non-resistant wood with

Xylazel Primer against rotting, blue stain fungi and wood boring insects.

Coverage

Around 12 m²/l per coat.

Directions for use

The product comes ready to use. Stir and mix before and during application.

It can be applied with a brush, roller or sprayer. Apply the recommended amount, in two or more coats.

Do not apply at temperatures above 30°C nor with forecast rain in 48 hours.

Maintenance

For maintenance, there is no need to remove earlier coats of Xylazel Sol Decking.

Surfaces must be cleaned well before recoating. If necessary, apply pressurised water.

Cleaning of tools Use soap and water.

4. SPECIAL INDICATIONS

Storage and handling

For storage and handling, please observe current regulations. Storage must be protected against freezing and high temperatures. Avoid spillage into watercourses. Follow the instructions on the product safety sheet.
